This new sedan with classic Down East lines is a quick, quiet cruiser with joystick handling to boot, thanks to Zeus pod drives. Add to that a good turn of speed (more than 32 knots at wide open), fuel efficiency (about 26 gph at 25 knots) and livable accommodations and you have a distinctive 40-foot cruiser. The cockpit has a new L-shaped settee with a cherry table and two aft-facing seats. Twin adjustable Stidd seats face the helm, where visibility is excellent in every direction. This blue-water catamaran comes on the heels of Africat's 420, which we tested with a pair of Volvo IPS pod drives. We were impressed with that boat's fuel efficiency and precise joystick handling, particularly around the dock. The new 380 is offered with that propulsion too, and that's good news for any twin-hull fan in search of better maneuverability. More conventional skippers can go with the 315 hp Yanmars or stern-drives and Axius. As for accommodations, the 380 is available in a three- or four-cabin layout with two, three or four heads.
